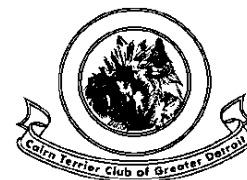

CODE OF ETHICS



The Cairn Terrier Club of Greater Detroit, in order to protect, preserve, and promote the purebred Cairn Terrier, does hereby set forth this Code of Ethics. When confronted with a situation not covered in this agreement, the member shall conduct himself as he would expect to be treated under similar circumstances.

The breeder shall at all times breed for the improvement of the breed as exemplified by the AKC Standard for that breed. The breeder, to the best of his/her knowledge, shall only use for breeding, adults which are of sound temperament and are free from genetic defects. Breeding stock shall conform as closely as possible to the AKC Standard for that breed.

Both dogs and bitches will not be used for breeding before they reach maturity both physical and mental. In most cases, this will be around 15 months for the stud dog and 18 months for the bitch. Ideally, neither should be bred before 12 months of age. We shall also restrict our bitches to one litter per year. In the event, however, that the bitch is bred on two successive seasons, that bitch shall not be bred during the next season.

Stud service shall be refused to any bitch that is unregistered, and to any bitch considered to be in poor health, of unsound temperament, or exhibiting serious hereditary faults. Nor shall a dog be used at stud that exhibits these failings. In the event that a mating cannot be accomplished with the stud contracted, no substitutions of studs or artificial insemination shall be done without the prior consent of the owner of the bitch. Breedings shall be done for the betterment of the breed only and not for any other purpose. Studs shall be used sparingly.

The breeder shall not sell or donate dogs or puppies to commercial dog wholesalers, retailers, for commercial research, agents or unethical breeders, nor to any buyer where there is reason to believe that the puppy or dog will not be properly cared for. Further, the breeder shall not sell to anyone in litter lots.

The seller shall inform the buyer of the characteristics of the breed and supply written instructions on feeding and maintenance of the particular dog sold. A medical history including a record of inoculations and fecal examinations shall be provided with the dog. The breeder shall make available to the novice, the benefit of his advice and experience.

The breeder shall fairly represent to the purchaser any stock offered for sale, and will not use misleading or untruthful statements in selling or advertising. Advertising shall be in good taste, restrained, and without derogatory remarks made or hinted concerning the methods, animals or reputation of other breeders. It is recommended that the breeder issue a written health guarantee. The seller shall furnish the buyer of a dog with a pedigree.

Registration papers, litter registration papers, or transfer forms are to be in the possession of the buyer within three months from the date of sale or given upon final payment for the dog unless delayed by the American Kennel Club. While certificates are pending, registration data (whelping date, registered names and numbers of the sire and dam, and breeder's name) will be provided. No dog will be sold until after litter registration application has been made to the AKC or handled in accordance with the AKC rules. Exceptions shall be made only where papers are to be withheld by **common written agreement**.

To avoid misunderstandings and for the protection of both buyer and seller, the use of sales contracts is strongly recommended to cover guarantees or agreements relative to the sale, with signed copies for each party involved.

NOTE: Under AKC rules (Chapter 3, Section 6) all forms necessary for registration **MUST** be completed and supplied unless agreed otherwise in written, signed statements.

Good sportsmanship shall be advanced by all members.
